In fiscal year 2010 Community Action Agencies served 365,000 individuals and 140,000 households. Of those households:

- 28% of families are at or below 50% of poverty
- 16% of families are over 51% - 75% of poverty
- 18% of families are over 76% - 100% of poverty
- 16% of families are over 101% - 125% of poverty
- 13% of families are over 126% - 150% of poverty
- 5% of families are over 151% - 175% of poverty
- 2% of families are over 176% - 200% of poverty
- 2% of families are over 200% of poverty
